Welcome to INSPIRE 2025

INSPIRE 2025—is a leading regional conference dedicated to advancing implementation science in public health. Hosted by the Department of Public Health at Qatar University, the conference serves as a platform to connect researchers, policymakers, practitioners, and community stakeholders committed to translating research into real-world impact.

At INSPIRE 2025, we bridge the gap between what we know and what we do in public health implementation.

TYPES OF ABSTRACTS ACCEPTED

1. Oral Presentations (15 minutes) – A detailed in-person presentation followed by Q&A.
2. Symposia & Panel Discussions (45 minutes) – A collaborative session featuring multiple speakers exploring a complex topic.
3. Poster Presentations – A visual summary of research findings, displayed for interaction with attendees.

THEMES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

We welcome abstract submissions related to the following key themes:

- Health Policy Implementation & Evaluation
- Strengthening Health Systems & Service Delivery
- Community-Based Public Health Interventions
- Innovative Research Methods in Implementation Science
- Equity, Global Health & Public Health Challenges in the Region
- Technology & Digital Health and innovation in Implementation Research

Abstracts should focus on the implementation, adaptation, scaling, and evaluation of evidence-based interventions in public health settings.

Debates & Special Sessions: The conference will also feature structured debates on controversial or emerging topics in implementation science.

Presentation Consent & Publication

Authors will be asked to confirm consent for:

1. Publishing abstracts on the official INSPIRE 2025 website.
2. Recording and sharing presentations with registered attendees.

If you have any concerns regarding publication or recording, please indicate this during submission.

Submission Guidelines - Oral Presentations

Abstracts should be no more than 300 words and structured as follows:

1. Title
2. Background (Brief context and significance of the study)
3. Objectives (Clear aims and expected outcomes)
4. Methods (Study design, intervention, or implementation approach)
5. Results (Preliminary or final findings, if available)
6. Conclusion (Implications for practice, policy, or future research)

All abstracts must be submitted online via [submission link] by **May 18, 2025**.

Submission Guidelines - Panel Discussion

To express your interest in presenting a Panel Discussion at the INSPIRE 2025 Conference on Advancing Public Health Through Implementation Science, please complete this form.

Each panel session should include:

1. Three oral presentations
2. Three presenters
3. One facilitator/moderator

This format is designed as an interactive discussion featuring three or more expert speakers who will present case studies and insights on a complex public health or implementation science topic.

Panel Session Structure:

Each presenter is encouraged to focus on discussion rather than slides.

Individual presentations should be kept concise (maximum 5 minutes each).

A minimum of 20 minutes should be allocated for questions and interactive discussions between the speakers, moderator, and audience.

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Abstract Selection & Review Process

All submissions will be peer-reviewed by a panel of implementation science and public health experts. The review committee will evaluate abstracts based on the following criteria:

1. Scientific Rigor – Does the abstract describe a project that uses sound methodology?
2. Relevance to Conference Themes – Does the abstract align with the core themes of INSPIRE 2025?
3. Innovation & Originality – Is the research novel or does it present new implementation insights?
4. Practical Application – Does the study contribute to improving public health implementation?
5. Clarity & Quality – Is the abstract well-written and well-structured?

Final decisions on presentation type (oral, poster, panel discussion) will be made by the review committee.

Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent by July 9, 2025.
